CECILIA AND GARRETT BOONE are influential Dallas philanthropists making a meaningful impact on the community.

CECILIA has committed to the fight for gender equity and focuses on changing the lives of women and girls. She has been active on the boards of Planned Parenthood Federation, the Dallas Women's Foundation, Girls Inc. of Metropolitan Dallas, Planned Parenthood of North Texas, Children at Risk, Human Rights Initiative and Annie's List.

GARRETT has a passion for efforts in creating a more sustainable environment. He is co-founder of The Container Store, which has grown into a national retailer. He is involved with the Texas Business for Clean Air Foundation, the Trinity Park Conservancy, the Dallas Women's Foundation and Dallas ISD Star Commission.

RICHIE BUTLER is the senior pastor of St. Paul United Methodist Church in downtown Dallas and the senior managing director of the Prescott Group. As a response to the tragic events of July 7, 2016 and conversations with Dallas community leaders, Pastor Butler founded the Year of Unity on the belief that "what unites us is greater than what divides us". The programs strive to build and sustain communities through dialogue, community building events, education and empowerment with a focus in race relations and racial unity. He is a member of the SMU Board of Trustees and the Communities Foundation of Texas Board of Trustees, and is involved with the Dallas Assembly and the Real Estate Council.





SIDNEY AND TAKISHA MONCRIEF operate Moncrief One Team, offering unique and innovative solutions through training and resources. The organization is committed to personal and professional development of individuals, teams and organizations.

SIDNEY is a newly inducted NBA Hall-of-Famer. He spent over a decade in the NBA playing with both the Milwaukee Bucks and Atlanta Hawks. During his NBA career, he became a five-time NBA All Star, five-time member of the NBA All-Defensive team, a two-time NBA Defensive Player of the Year, and an NBA All-Pro. 
FIFTH ANNUAL BUILDING BRIDGES ACROSS DALLAS LUNCHEON



The All Stars Project (ASP) is a 38-year old national nonprofit that uses performance to create exposure and opportunity for our inner-city youth and their families. ASP reaches over 20,000 inner-city youth and families across the country through free innovative afterschool development programs in Dallas, Chicago, New York, Newark, Jersey City and the San Francisco Bay Area. Our programs are open to all young people. We visit schools and knock on doors in poor communities and invite everyone to join the All Stars.

ASP OF DALLAS

In 2013, ASP brought afterschool development programs to Dallas to engage the 40% of youth living in poverty. ASP reaches young people from high poverty areas in West Dallas, South Dallas, North Dallas, Vickery Meadow and South Oak Cliff. Our impact over the past year includes:

DEVELOPMENT SCHOOL FOR YOUTH

Through the **Development School for Youth** (**DSY**), young people learn the performance of the business world through workshops led by professionals, culminating in 6-week paid internships with our partners in the professional world. Each summer over 400 youth nationwide are placed in internships at our partner organizations.

In Dallas, 57 young people were placed in internship sponsored by 35 companies like Hunt Consolidated, Fidelity Investments, EY and many more.
