The All Stars Project of Chicago reaches thousands of our city's poorest young people every year through innovative Afterschool Development programs that help them grow by learning new performances—onstage and off. These programs are open to all young people who want to participate, regardless of GPA and no matter how well they are doing in school or in life.

In All Stars programs, like the All Stars Talent Show Network (ASTSN) and the Development School for Youth (DSY), young people try new things, become more worldly, and see new possibilities for themselves and their communities. Through the DSY, All Stars partners with some of the most successful executives and companies across Chicagoland who lead development workshops and provide paid summer internships for close to 80 young people each year from some of the poorest communities in Chicago, helping them learn to perform as professionals.

All Stars Project of Chicago has launched a campaign to establish our city's first Center for Afterschool Development in the heart of downtown. The Center will be a hub for everyone who wants to bring performance and development to our city. It will connect youth from our south and west sides to each other, and to caring adults who are their partners in growth.
