All Stars Project raises over \$2.25 million

Youth performing arts organization The All Stars Project (ASP) held its annual gala celebrating the nonprofit's 40th anniversary and raised a record-breaking \$2.25 million in private funding to engage poverty, inequality and social injustice.

The virtual event was hosted by Dometi Pongo, host of the MTV series "True Life Crime," and attended by 1,100 people from across the country. Young people from New York, New Jersey, Chicago, Dallas, and San Francisco shared statements and performances.
