# **Development School for Youth** (DSY)

With a 25-year track record and over 5,000 alumni, the DSY creates leadership development and paid summer internship opportunities for youth in partnership with the business community. Last summer, 200 youth participated in in-person, remote, and hybrid internships provided by partner companies such as EY, Paramount Global, MetLife, JPMorgan Chase, Onyx Equities, AIG, PSEG, and CBRE. DSY has been featured in Forbes and the Chicago Tribune as a model program in preparing youth for the business world and creating meaningful engagement, as our corporate partners respond to calls of action for diversity and equity in the workplace.

# Supporting All Stars Helps Engage 10,000 Youth and Families Every Year!

### **Development Coaching**

A brand-new program of the All Stars developed in response to COVID-19, Development Coaching connects young people with caring adults and industry leaders. These adults help guide and enhance each young person's professional and personal development. Since 2020, we've matched over 1,500 young people and adults through the program!

#### **Performance Programs**

Through the All Stars Talent Show Network, where everyone who auditions (on time!) makes the show; to Youth Onstage!, our free youth theatre school; to the many virtual performance festivals we have created over the past three years, young people ages 5-25 perform 'on stage' at the All Stars and in the process, build their confidence, grow their network, and experience success.




# **Kate Barton**Global Vice Chair, EY
