About the All Stars Project, Inc.

Founded in 1981, the All Stars Project (ASP) creates free, outside-of-school programs for youth from poor and underserved communities. As a national nonprofit organization, All Stars runs programs in New York City, Newark and Jersey City, Dallas, the San Francisco Bay Area, and Chicago,

in addition to hosting virtual programs reaching young people across the country. All Stars encourages young people to try new performances, onstage and in life, which supports their development and allows them to see new possibilities for themselves and their communities.

Our Programs

Development School for Youth

With a 26-year track record and over 5,000 alumni, the Development School for Youth (DSY) creates leadership training and paid summer internship opportunities for youth in the business community. This summer, over 200 youth will participate in internships across the country. In Chicago, our 2024 intern hosts include 360 Chicago, AMLI, Birch Lake, Cook County Sheriff's Office, Cooley, Driehaus Capital Management, Equity Residential, Hilco, JPMorgan, KPMG, NGE, Nuveen, and Polsinelli. DSY has been featured in the Chicago Tribune and Forbes as a model program in preparing youth for the business world and creating meaningful engagement, as our corporate partners respond to new calls of action for diversity and equity in the workplace.

Development Coaching

Created in response to the pandemic, Development Coaching is a virtual program that matches caring adults (coaches) with young adults ages 18-24 (coachees). The adults help guide and enhance each young person's professional and personal development through six one-hour sessions over an 8-week period. Since 2020, we've matched over 1,000 young people and adults in the program!

Performance Programs

Through on-stage and online performance activities, All Stars uses an innovative performance-based approach to help young people from across the country (and the world!) grow their confidence on stage and in life!



Our Programs

Operation Conversation: Cops & Kids

Cops & Kids is an award-winning, police-community relations model program run in partnership with local police departments in New York City, NY and Newark, NJ. We have worked directly with over 5,000 youth and officers over the past decade who have built new relationships with one another through their engagement with the program.

Operation Conversation

Operation Conversation is the All Stars
Project's newest bridge-building initiative
created to address the social and racial
divides in America. Operation Conversation
gives people from all walks of life new and
effective tools to develop their empathy,
appreciation, and listening skills, all while
exercising their curiosity 'muscles.' The
workshop builds diverse relationships,
engages racism, and promotes racial healing
in everyday life through the power of
performance.



All Stars Project of Chicago

Working in neighborhoods that have been hit the hardest by violence – the South and West Sides – the All Stars Project of Chicago has touched the lives of over 40,000 young people since 2007. The business and philanthropic communities have stepped up with All Stars to address the city's tough issues and are expanding the All Stars Talent Show Network and the Development School for Youth at record speed.

Off the success of our growth, All Stars established a new Hub for Afterschool Development in the Printers Row neighborhood in downtown Chicago in March 2023. Occupying the entire second floor, this nearly 6,300-square-foot space is easily accessible from public transportation

and includes an open-concept workspace, offices, and a large multi-purpose "collaborative performance space" for hosting our award-winning program activities, workshops, receptions, and more. The Hub allows ASP of Chicago to have a welcoming presence and leverage even more partnerships and collaborations as we work to bring the transformational power of performance to underserved youth, their families, and communities.
